MEMORABLE GAMES

1995 — Lamont Parrish scores 30 points as Bethune-Cookman posts its highest Ocean Center total with a 100-78 win over Morgan State. Parrish's 30 remains an Wildcat individual high.

1997 -- Hometown hero Vince Carter makes a triumph return to Daytona Beach as he and the top-ranked North Carolina Tar Heels throttle the Wildcats 97-46. Antwan Jamison scored 22 points and Carter added 18 — mostly on dunks—before leaving the game after getting hit in the face defending a drive.

1999 — Georgetown and legendary coach John Thompson escape Daytona Beach after the Wildcats led by Horace Broadnax, a former Hoya guard, nearly pull off the upset. The Wildcats closed to one point and had the ball for the final shot, but Joseph Touomou knocked the ball away from Bethune-Cookman's Johnny McClenton in the waning moments. Kevin Braswell, who led all scorers with 21 points, sent the ball back to Touomou, who sank two free throws to ice the victory. Freddie Cole led the Wildcats with 20 points. Afterwards Thompson jokingly vowed he'd never come back to Daytona Beach.

2011 — The Wildcats easily dispatched North Carolina Central 73-60 for their sixth consecutive victory, but it was what was happening in Greensboro, N.C. that started a celebration. North Carolina A&T's victory over Morgan State gave the Wildcats their first-ever Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference regular season title.
